The EAEU Institute was established in December 2010 in the form of an autonomous noncommercial organization as a creative team focused on research and analysis of Eurasian integration processes. The key factor which determined the establishing of the Institute was development of integration, civilization and modernization processes in the post-Soviet territory, first of all in member and observer states of the Eurasian Economic Community – EurAsEC (known today as EAEU).

According to its statutory aims and objectives, the EAEU Institute conducts its activities in the territory of the Russian Federation in close cooperation and partnership with such organizations as the Eurasian Economic Commission (EEC), CIS, CSTO, SCO, the Union State of Russia and Belarus, the CIS Interparliamentary Assembly, the Russia Today international news agency and others.

The EAEU Institute is an association of unique specialists who are members of the Eurasian Economic Integration Board of the Russian Academy of Sciences and expert councils and institutions of a number of federal and regional authorities.
